BACKPACK FOR KIDS

Nearly 1 in 5 children in our area live in extreme poverty and thus are at high risk of hunger. In partnership with the Tarrant Area Food Bank, the Community Caring Center provides children at local schools with backpacks full of healthy, kid-friendly food each Friday to last through the weekend. For kids who depend on their school's free or reduced-priced meal program, the food they receive might be all they eat between lunch on Friday and breakfast on Monday.
